Qualifications:

- Minimum Education: High School Diploma or GED preferred.
- Minimum Experience: Desire to make a positive impact in the lives of youth is a MUST have! Some soccer experience (playing or coaching) is preferred but not required. Sporting or athletics background a plus but not essential.
- Must be at least 18 years old.
- Access to reliable transportation.
- Consent to and complete a background check (MSYSA will cover the cost).
- Ability to assist the head coach in leading 25-45 students aged 6-11, through sport and life-teaching moments.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Attend one or more practices per week for a daily commitment of approximately 2 hours (3:00/5:30 pm typical timeframe).
- Assist with the facilitation of the day's lesson plan.
- Participate in games and activities with the students.
- Work with Site Lead and volunteers to create a positive learning environment.

Special Requirements

- New hires are subject to a criminal background check (paid by MSYSA).
- New hires must complete SafeSport and Heads Up Concussion training in addition to program training (Approx. 3-4 hours of total training) and one in person field training. A training stipend will be awarded (at the end of season) to all coach-mentors who complete required training and finish the Let's Play! season.

Selection Process

- Bilingual Spanish speaking applicants are encouraged to apply.
- Female applicants are encouraged to apply.
- Applications will be prescreened before candidates are invited to an interview.
- Online application process is STRONGLY preferred. If online access is not available you may submit via mail, e-mail, or deliver in person before the closing date and time.
